

CYTISUS MONSPESSULANUS L., ESTABLISHED IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA.—Previously, *Cytisus monspessulanus* has been reported as “perniciously” naturalized in California near the coast from Ventura County northward (Munz, P. A., A California Flora, 1959). Recently, I discovered a population of 256 living and 62 dead individuals of this species well established in oak woodland at the east end of William Hiesey County Park in the Cuyamaca Mountains, San Diego County (Keeley 2583, CSUSD).
